## ABOUT THE STUDY

### Why is this Study needed?

Dakota County and the City of Lakeville are partnering to coordinate planning efforts and identify improvements on County Road 9 (Dodd Boulevard) and 179th Street in the City of Lakeville. The study is needed to:

- Transfer of roadways requires a review of existing facilities to ensure safety and operation.
- Assess pavement conditions.
- Establish a safer and more reliable East-to-West roadway.
- Accommodate an areawide system and travel network to better serve the region in the future.

### What is happening?

The scope of work for this study includes:

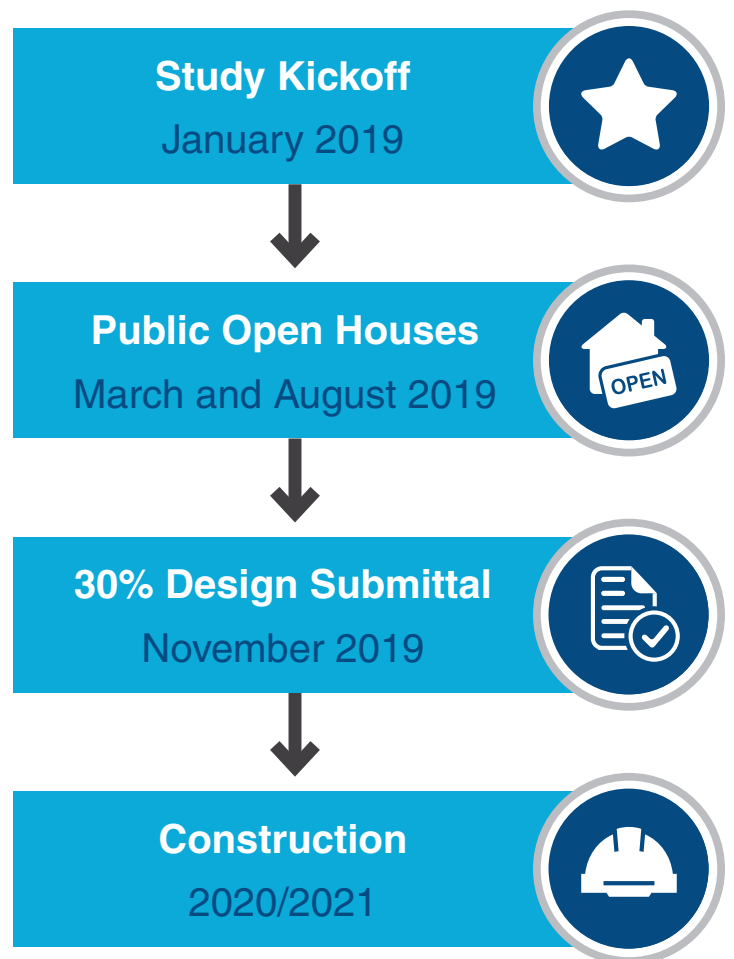
- Preliminary feasibility review
- Analysis of intersection and roadway improvements
- Preliminary engineering designs
- Surveying
- Cost estimates

This work will better inform Dakota County and the City of Lakeville on how the two segments need to be upgraded to meet future traffic demands.

### Where are we now?

The study team has developed concept design alternatives for Dodd Boulevard and 179th Street. These concepts will be refined based on public input received and design considerations to identify a preliminary design for each segment.
